We design your smile and transmit this information, along with a shade, to a special laboratory. They fabricate the Lumineers in about a week or so. Since there is no tooth reduction, you don't even need temporaries. That by itself is quite a miracle.



About one to two weeks later you come to the office and we place your Lumineers. No anesthesia is required and you leave the office with your new smile in about one to two hours.
