Joe said, "But Ted is 80 years old and half senile!"

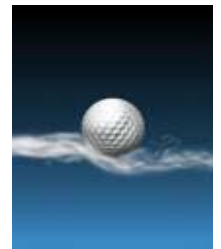
His wife replied, "Yes, but his eyesight is incredible."
