



Ceramic Inlays

Although I know that we discussed the advantages and disadvantages of your new **ceramic Inlay**, I thought you might want to have a little more information. So here goes.....

- **Ceramic Inlays** are one of the most natural looking restorations that are currently available. They feel and look just like natural healthy and attractive teeth.
- **Ceramic Inlays** tend to preserve more of the natural tooth. Silver amalgam fillings require a greater amount of tooth removal in order to establish the necessary retention form while **Ceramic Inlays** utilize current bonding techniques for their retention.
- **Ceramic Inlays** actually strengthen your tooth by forming a bond between the inlay itself and your tooth. This bonding, according to researchers, can help to reinforce many weakened teeth.
- Clinical studies, for over six (6) years, have demonstrated that the laboratory heat and pressure cured **Ceramic Inlays** resist wear similar to the natural tooth.



After placement of your new inlay or inlays, you may feel some sensitivity to cold. This is not abnormal and should disappear within a week or two. The same sensitivity also occurs after placement of other types of restorations and is usually temporary in nature.
